

Swonder Ice Arena Re-Opening Protocol as it relates to Freestyle Skaters

1. Freestyle and Stick Time Sessions are limited to 20 people per session. Spots are available on a first come first serve basis with a limit of 2 sessions per skater per day.
2. Coaches wanting to teach private lessons are able to do so and are included in the 20- person count. Pros are asked to text Danielle by 8am the day the lessons are scheduled and inform her what session(s) they are planning to teach on.
3. The facility will open for the day at 9am with the first freestyle of the day beginning at 9:15am. The line to enter and check in will begin near the outside ticket window and continue towards the former skate park entrance.
4. The majority of sessions are one hour and \$7.00 per session. The exception is the 9:15-11:15am session which is \$14.00.
If a skater chooses to skate the 9:15am session it will count as the skaters 2 freestyles for the day.
5. Skaters may enter the facility no earlier than 15 minutes before their scheduled session and must leave the facility within 15 minutes of their session end time.
6. Any/all off-ice warm ups/stretchers will need to be done in a location outside the facility.
7. All Skaters must pay BEFORE entering the facility at the outside ticket window. No transactions will be handled at the information desk.
8. Once inside the facility there will be spaces marked 6 feet apart for skaters to put on their skates.
9. While skating, should a skater need to retie skates, there will be chairs just off the ice surface appropriately spaced for skaters to do so.
10. Some of the entry and exit gates to/from the hockey boxes will be closed. Please pay attention to signage when entering and exiting the ice.
11. There are spaces marked in the hockey boxes for a max of 4 coaches per box.
12. There is a maximum of 4 marked spaces in the East hallway available for spectators. No spectators will be allowed in the bleacher area or rink side until further notice.
13. Swonder Ice Arena staff will clean the players boxes, & music box area between sessions.
14. The common areas in the lobby will be cleaned on an hourly basis.
15. Siblings and additional family members are discouraged to enter the facility in order to maintain an occupancy of 50 patrons or less in the lobby. If a parent or family member enters the facility, masks are encouraged but not required.
16. Skaters will not be allowed to use Locker Room 1 until further notice. Upon their first time back to the facility they may go into the locker room to get their things. Moving forward skaters will need to bring their skates with them and take them at the conclusion of each session. Locker room renewal dates will be extended to compensate for time they are unable to use the locker room.
